What Is Covered

At ALLINWOOD, we take pride in crafting premium engineered hardwood flooring designed to last for generations. We stand behind the quality of our products with the following warranties:

25-Year Residential Surface Finish Warranty

5-Year Commercial Surface Finish Warranty

Lifetime Limited Structural Integrity Warranty

These warranties apply exclusively to the original purchaser and are non-transferable.

Surface Finish Warranty

ALLINWOOD guarantees that the surface finish on your flooring will not wear through or peel under normal use:

Residential applications – for 25 years from the date of purchase.

Commercial applications – for 5 years from the date of purchase.

This coverage is valid only if all official ALLINWOOD care and maintenance guidelines are followed.

Structural Integrity Warranty

Your ALLINWOOD flooring is protected by a lifetime limited structural warranty, ensuring it remains free from delamination, splitting, or warping due to manufacturing defects.

What Is Not Covered

This warranty does not apply to damages or issues caused by:

Improper installation, storage, or handling.

Failure to follow ALLINWOOD's official installation or care instructions.

Non-approved adhesives, cleaners, underlayment's, or tools.

Moisture, spills, plumbing leaks, or wet mopping.

Improper climate control or subfloor conditions.

Installation over radiant heat systems without adherence to ALLINWOOD's radiant guidelines.

Heavy traffic, abuse, negligence, or pet damage.

Furniture movement, high heels, or abrasive materials like sand or dirt.

Normal wood characteristics such as: color, tone, or grain variation.

Seasonal gapping or board movement.

Knots, mineral streaks, or other natural markings.

Fading or color change from sunlight, aging, or oxidation.

Flooring with visible defects installed without prior notice to ALLINWOOD.

Any damage where defective material accounts for less than 10% of the total floor area.

Radiant Heat Installation

Some ALLINWOOD products are approved for use with radiant heating. To ensure warranty coverage:

Confirm the product is radiant-heat approved.

Follow ALLINWOOD's Radiant Heat Installation Guide.

Limit floor surface temperature to 82°F (28°C).

Use gradual temperature increases and a dedicated thermostat.

Sudden temperature changes or improper system installation will void your warranty.
